United Way's ALICE Research Initiative


The research initiative provides data that identifies the needs of this vulnerable population, stimulates meaningful discussion, and ultimately informs strategies for positive change.

Based on partnerships among United Ways, nonprofits, academic institutions, corporations, and other state organizations.

The work has grown from a pilot research program in Morris County, New Jersey in 2009 to 21 states and more than 648 United Ways.

Household SURVIVAL Budget
Comprised of conservative cost estimates of the following household essentials:

Housing	Health Care
Child Care	Technology
Food	Taxes
Transportation	10% misc/fluctuating

The Survival budget is the **bare minimum** cost to live and work in the modern economy. **It is not sustainable over time, and it is not meant to be a recommended budget.**

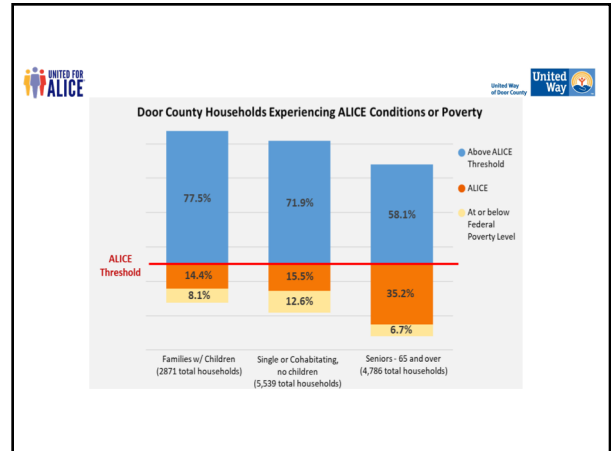
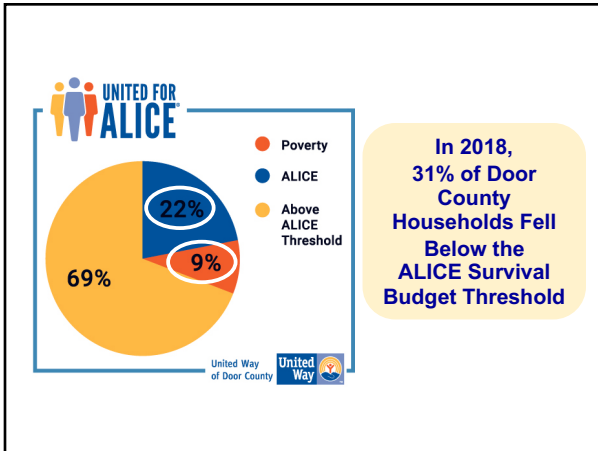

BENEFITS OF SUFFICIENT INCOME

When individuals and families have sufficient income, it positively impacts those individuals... and also the greater community. For example:

Impact on ALICE Household	Impact on the Community
Decreased stress; better mental & physical health	Lower healthcare costs; less spending on emergency services
Decreased stress & better health	Improved workplace productivity
Improved access to preventative care	Decreased health-wealth gap
Improved academic performance	Decreased income disparity; lower crime rates
Improved access to job opportunities	More diverse labor market
Decreased "digital divide"	Increased civic participation
Greater asset accumulation over time	Increased financial stability of community
